

## PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BOTH FEI AND NATIONAL COMPETITORS!

In an effort to provide more thorough biosecurity at Events, the FEI has proposed new rules for 2022 concerning Arrival Exams and using the FEI HorseApp. Because of the new rules, we WILL NOT BE ABLE TO STABLE ANY FEI HORSES WITH NATIONAL HORSES. If you have both, we will try to put them in barns as close to each other as possible, but they WILL be in different barns.

FEI Competitors, please remember to sign yourself up on the HorseApp and for three days prior to your arrival (if you arrive Thursday it means Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday) to record twice daily (am and pm) temperatures on each horse you will be bringing to the event.

In addition, you must have your Horse Health Self-Certification Form completed in the HorseApp PRIOR to your arrival. Not doing so will only slow down the arrival exam process for you AND your fellow competitors.

Please BRING YOUR OWN THERMOMETER for you or your groom to take your horses(s) temperature at the Arrival Exam, to be entered into the HorseApp, <u>and for your twice-daily temps during the</u> competition.

In the short format CCI, we will have you trot your horse at the Arrival Exam. As veterinary professionals, we understand that your horse is just off the trailer and will take that into consideration when you jog. In NO CIRCUMSTANCES should you go to the FEI Stables or Event arenas/riding areas prior to having your exam. Doing so jeopardizes the biosecurity of the entire event <u>and is against the FEI rules</u>.

If you arrive outside of the designated Arrival Exam times, by FEI rule your horse will be put into the isolation Stabling until an Arrival Exam is completed so please contact the Stable View office in advance at 484-356-3173 if you will be arriving outside of the designated times, which are 9AM – 12PM and 1PM – 5PM on Thursday, and 7:30AM-10AM on Friday.

NATIONAL competitors, please plan to also check your horse temperatures twice daily as an added precaution. We will provide temperature charts to post on stall doors, or in trailers if not stabling.

## Other important arrival protocols:

- Day Parking will enter at Gate 2. ALL FEI HORSES COMING AND GOING EACH DAY MUST BE RECORDED ON HORSEAPP WHEN THEY ARRIVE AND DEPART TO/FROM STABLE VIEW AND LOCATION OF ORIGIN.
- Only National Horses stabling will enter Gate 4
- Only FEI Horses stabling will enter Gate 3
- National AND FEI horses traveling together will enter Gate 3
- Don't forget to complete your FEI inspection BEFORE you put your FEI horse in its stall
- Remember: FEI and National horses are not allowed to stable together, as you would then have to use the HorseApp for national horses, complete FEI registrations, and go through the in-barn exams, which will result in delays for everyone.
