

2023 SEASON Schooling days

An Eventing Academy comprises up to three parts: Friday, Open Schooling Cross Country only. Saturday, up to Three Phase Schooling and Sunday, Unrecognized Schooling Horse Trials**, Combined Test, Stadium Round, or Dressage Test.

Friday and Saturday SCHOOLING DAYS:

Friday and Saturday Schooling Days are open to everyone irrespective of competing in Sunday's Unrecognized HT**.

Schooling Days provide an opportunity to school in a relaxed environment, using the Dressage Arena, Stadium Arena, and over the same Cross Country Course as will be used for Sunday's Unrecognized HT**.

The Stadium course for the Horse Trial will use the same jumps, but will be a different course.

Online Registration for the Open Schooling Days is required the day prior by 5:00pm. Please pre-register via Event Entries. Payment is required at the time of entry. Entries will be limited to 150 horses each day. Please submit a negative Coggins with entry.

CROSS COUNTRY SCHOOLING

To Cross Country School, Riders must have a Cross Country vest. A medical armband is required if Riders have a major medical condition that first responder would need to know about. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

A grounds person should be with every Rider.

* NEW * STADIUM SCHOOLING

Stadium schooling will start with low and end with high levels. New scheduled times are listed below.

Riders are requested to school one stadium round at a time. If horse and rider are having difficulty at a particular jump, we ask after 3 attempts the rider leave the arena and return later.

DRESSAGE SCHOOLING

All Dressage will be on Attwood Equestrian Surfaces footing. Dressage schooling is limited to fifteen-minutes at a time.

Students must list their trainer on their forms. Each student will count as one point. At the end of the Series, the top three trainers with the highest student attendance will receive 1st - 3rd cash awards:

1st - \$500, 2nd - \$300, and 3rd - \$200.
