Aiken isn't just a winter equestrian destination anymore. Riders flock to Aiken year round now thanks to the many facilities that offer equestrian activities throughout the Summer. Stable View had the largest July Eventing Academy in history this year. In addition, Stable View hosts an August Eventing Academy, a dressage show every month of the summer, a horse trial in June, and four weeks of Hunter/Jumper shows.

Stable View isn't the only place that hosts Summer horse events. Bruce's Field hosts Hunter/Jumper and Dressage shows. Highfields also has summer Hunter/Jumper shows. New Bridge Polo and

Country Club and Aiken Polo Club host polo matches through the middle of June. Full Gallop Farm and Sporting Days Farm continue to have horse trials throughout the summer months. The Vista also caters to event riders all Summer. More and more riders are basing their programs out of Aiken full-time.

This is seen in entry numbers and support of Summer shows. Stable View does their best to help keep horses and riders cool all summer. Many shows take advantage of the covered arena. There is also a misting station for horses, an air-conditioned rider's lounge, and cold water and soda throughout the farm in coolers.
