Starter: USEF 2022 Starter- small arena (20m x 40m)

Beginner Novice: USEF 2022 BN Eventing Test A - small arena (20m x 40m)

Novice: USEF 2022 Novice Eventing Test A - small arena (20m x 40m)

Training: USEF 2022 Training Eventing Test A - small arena (20m x 40m)

Late Fees: Entries received after the closing date will be subject to a \$25 late fee for the Horse Trials, \$15 late fee for the Combined Tests and a \$10 late fee for the Dressage Test of Choice and Stadium Round. Entries must be accompanied by payment to be processed. Entries received without payment will not be accepted.

Pony Club Discount: Active Pony Club Members receive 50% off only their entry fees (**not applicable to "Saturday and Sunday Discount"**)

"Saturday and Sunday Discount": Includes all 3 phases of Saturday schooling day and the Entry Fee for Sunday HT on the same weekend - \$240.

Other Information

Sunday – One-day schooling horse trial, combined test, dressage test of choice, or stadium round.

Dressage and Stadium Jumping will be on Attwood Equestrian Surfaces Footing.

Ride Times and Stabling Chart will be available on the Stable View Website and Event Entries.

Riders may wear cross-country attire for show jumping.

Medical armbands required for under-lying conditions.

Safety vest and ASTM approved helmets are required.

Braiding optional.

All dogs must be leashed.

Levels may be divided/combined depending on entries.

Eventing Academies will be held in accordance with current USEA and USEF rules.

Valid negative Coggins within last 12 months is required.



Awards

Ribbons awarded 1st through 6th place for HT and CT entries only. Ribbons and Tests will not be mailed.

TIP Awards and Prizes for the first and second highest placing Thoroughbred Horse at each level.

The 2024 Eventing Academy Series will be from December 2023 through November 2024. Year-end prizes will be awarded at the December 2024 Eventing Academy Awards Ceremony. Competitors placing 1st through 6th in their class will be awarded points as follows:

- 1st place – 7 points
- 2nd place – 5 points
- 3rd place – 4 points
- 4th place – 3 points
- 5th place – 2 points
- 6th place – 1 point
- Attendance – 1 point

Year end winners should collect prizes from the Stable View Office by December 31st, 2024.

Year-End Awards: The horse and rider combination with the most accumulated points at each level will receive a year-end prize. The horse and rider combination winning the most overall points will be presented with prizes to a value in excess of \$1,000. Ties will be broken by the lowest average score. The total value of prizes to be distributed is estimated to be in excess of \$20,000.

Trainer Incentive Award: The trainer who brings the most students to the Eventing Academy Sunday Schooling Show(s) will be eligible for year-end awards. Students must list their trainer on their entry forms. Each student will count as one point. 1st - \$500 cash, 2nd - \$300 cash & 3rd - \$200 cash. Ties will be broken by the lowest score the trainer had in the 2024 season.
