Beginner Novice: USEF 2026 BN Eventing Test A - small arena (20m x 40m)

Novice: USEF 2026 Novice Eventing Test A - small arena (20m x 40m)

Training: USEF 2026 Training Eventing Test A - small arena (20m x 40m)

Outstanding balances: Stable View reserves the right to refuse to accept an entry from any renter, owner, trainer, exhibitor or coach who has a past due balance owed to Stable View.

Late Fees: Entries received after the closing date will be subject to a \$25 late fee for the Horse Trials, \$15 late fee for the Combined Tests and a \$10 late fee for the Dressage Test of Choice and Stadium Round. Entries must be accompanied by payment to be processed. Entries received without payment will not be accepted.

Pony Club Discount: Active Pony Club Members who are aged 23 or younger are eligible to receive 50% off their entry fees (**not applicable to "Saturday and Sunday Discount"**)

"Saturday and Sunday Discount": Includes all 3 phases of Saturday schooling day and the Entry Fee for Sunday HT on the same weekend - \$240.

Other Information

Sunday – One-day schooling horse trial, combined test, dressage test of choice, or stadium round.

Dressage and Stadium Jumping will be on Attwood Equestrian Surfaces Footing.

Ride Times and Stabling Chart will be available on the Stable View Website and Event Entries.

Riders may wear cross-country attire for show jumping.

Medical armbands required for under-lying conditions.

Safety vest and ASTM approved helmets are required.

Braiding optional.

All dogs must be leashed.

Levels may be divided/combined depending on entries.

Eventing Academies will be held in accordance with current USEA and USEF rules.

Valid negative Coggins within last 12 months is required.

Tent Camping is not permitted.



Awards

Ribbons awarded 1st through 6th place for HT and CT entries only. Ribbons and Tests will not be mailed.

TIP Awards and Prizes for the first and second highest placing Thoroughbred Horse at each level. Please confirm your TIP number with the office prior to the show.

Trainer Incentive Award: The trainer who brings the most students to the Eventing Academy Sunday Schooling Show(s) will be eligible for year-end awards. Students must list their trainer on their entry forms. Each student will count as one point. 1st - \$500 cash, 2nd - \$300 cash, & 3rd - \$200 cash. Ties will be broken by the lowest score the trainer had in the 2025 season.



EA Championships in November

We will be hosting the Year-End Horse Trial (HT) Championships at our November Show in additon to the normal Horse Trial Divisions.

Qualifying: To qualify for the Championships you must have done ONE of the following at the prior Sunday HTs: (December, February, March, July, August, October)

- Placed 1st - 6th in a HT class at any of the listed shows
- OR
- Compete at 5 out of the 6 of the listed shows in HT classes

Qualifying will be based on the Horse/Rider combination during the season.

Competitors will qualify for the division in which they competed in during the season.

Qualified horse/rider pairs may show one level above the level they qualified at.

There will be \$20,000 in prizes to be awarded for the Championships.

Championship divisions will be split by age for the 2026 Championship show - 18 & under, and Adults (19 & over).
