

Brush up your show skills! Get the opportunity to school courses in a competition-like atmosphere. Jumpers pay per round and can add rounds at the gate. Hunters pay per height of jumps and are allowed to have multiple horses in the arena at once. Trainers are allowed in the arena.

# **Rules and Regulations**

#### **Health Requirements**

All horses must have valid proof of negative coggins test (within 12 months).

#### Rules

The use of De Gogue, Chambon, draw reins, and German Martingale are only permitted in warm-up.

ASTM approved helmets and boots required.

### **End of Series Loyalty Prizes**

Rider/horse combinations who attend 8 or more Institutes will receive year-end prizes.

Pairs who attend eleven shows will receive four prizes; those attending ten, three prizes; those attending nine, two prizes; and those attending eight, will receive one prize.
