An Eventing Academy is comprised of three parts:
Friday: Open Schooling Cross Country only.
Saturday: Three Phase Schooling, and
Sunday: Unrecognized Schooling Horse Trials, Combined Test, Stadium
Round, or Dressage Test.

Friday and Saturday Schooling Days

Friday and Saturday Schooling Days are open to everyone irrespective of competing in Sunday's Unrecognized HT.

Schooling Days provide an opportunity to school in a relaxed environment, using the Dressage Arena, Stadium Arena, and over the same Cross Country Course used for Sunday's Unrecognized HT.

The Stadium course for the Horse Trial will use the same jumps, but will be a different course.

Online Registration for the Open Schooling Days is required the day prior by midnight. Please preregister via Event Entries. Payment is required at the time of entry. Entries will be limited to 150 horses each day.

Please submit a negative Coggins with entry.

There will be no refunds for schooling days.

Includes all 3 phases of the Saturday schooling day and Sunday Horse Trials on the same weekend - \$240.

CROSS COUNTRY SCHOOLING

To Cross Country School, riders must have a Cross Country vest. A medical armband is required if riders have a major medical condition that first responders would need to know about. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

A grounds person should be with every rider.

Cross Country will close no later than 5pm.

STADIUM SCHOOLING

Stadium schooling will start with low and end with high levels. New scheduled times are listed below. Riders are requested to school one stadium round at a time and may not school back-to-back rounds. Repeat riders will go to the end of the queue to insure everyone gets a chance to school.

If horse and rider are having difficulty at a particular jump, we ask after 3 attempts the rider leave the arena and return later.
