The 2024 Recognized Hunter/Jumper Shows will be managed by Gary Young.

There are some big changes for the shows. The first being than a new arena is in the process of being created. It will be located between the Mark Phillips and Silva Arenas. There were

seventeen trees that had to be removed for this project. However, Stable View will be using them to create new cross country jumps. With the completion of the new arena, the Mark Phillips Arena will be used for the Jumpers. The New Arena and the existing Hunter Arena will be used for the Hunters. The Tree Arena will be set up for ticketed schooling all week.

Other plans for the 2024 season include moving the office to the upstairs of the Pavilion to allow easy access for trainers from the rings throughout the show day.

The Rider's Lounge will remain in the building alongside Springfield Church complete with beverages, snacks, and a space to get out of the weather.

The Welcome Stake will be the last class of the day on Thursday and the Grand Prix will be Saturday afternoon with a set start time.

After five paid stalls, trainers receive one free stall.
