

APRIL FOUR-STAR ON THE HORIZON:

With the conclusion of the Aiken Opener, the next recognized eventing show at Stable View is April 5th-7th. Riders will have the opportunity to compete at Training, Modified, Preliminary, Intermediate, and Advanced Horse Trials Divisions as well as Two, Three, and Four-star short FEI Divisions. The event will open on February 20th and will close March 19th.

There is a new coffin being built near the Pavilion that is designed to prepare four-star riders en route to Kentucky.

The Cross Country Courses for the Training, Modified, Intermediate, and Three-Star divisions will be designed by Mogie Bearden-Muller. Helen West is the assistant for the Three-Star. The Preliminary, Two-Star, Advanced, and Four-Star courses will be designed by Helen West. Mark Phillips will be the assistant for the Four-Star and Mogie will be the assistant for the Two-Star. All Stadium Jumping Courses will be designed by Chris Barnard.

There will be VIP Tickets sold for the VIP Experience. This will give ticket holders access to the upstairs of the Pavilion and catered food by Blue Collard and Beer and Wine from Ollie's Inn. The upstairs allows great viewing of both the Mark Phillips Arena as well as part of the Cross Country Course. Ticket prices are \$100 until Friday, March 15th before they will be raised to \$120.
